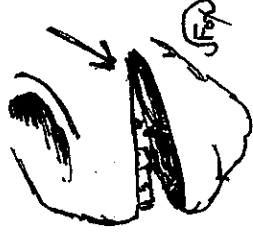
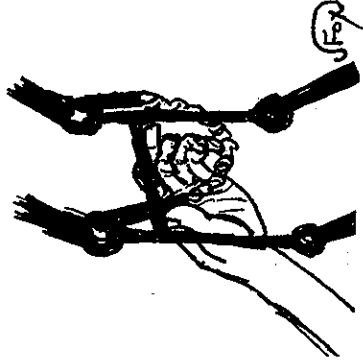


Bridle Your Horse

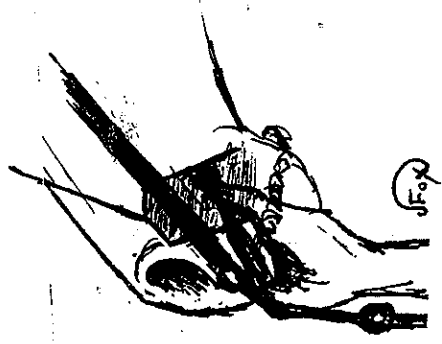
Put your reins over neck and cross the tails of reins for control. Standing on the left side of the horse at the horses' Throat Latch, grasp the top of the head stall with your right hand. Open the bit and curb with your thumb and fingers. Guide the horses' muzzle between the cheek straps of the bridle. Placing your forearm along his crest let your right hand drop over the poll between his ears. Stick your thumb in the corner of his mouth and gently pull the bit into his mouth with your right hand. Push the right ear forward with your left hand and pull the head stall over the ear, repeat on the left ear. Check to see everything is in place and fitting correctly.

1. Hold the bit with your left hand
And guide the bit



There are no teeth on the bars at the corners of the mouth.

2. Slide your thumb in the corner and use your left hand to guide the bit into the mouth



3. With your right hand over the poll:
Lift the bit into the mouth.

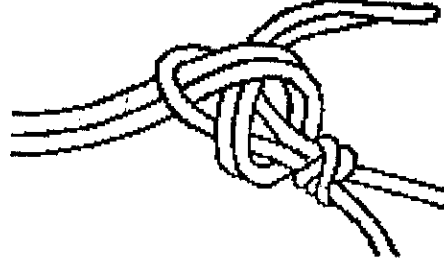
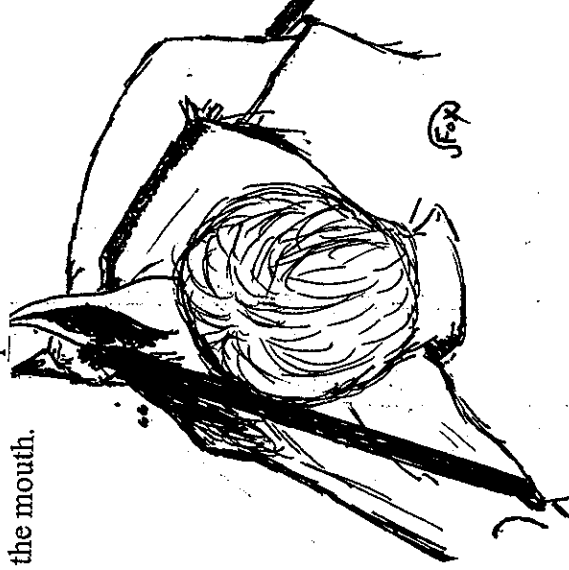


Diagram to tie rope halter

Tying your halter correctly will help eliminate slippage and won't tighten up if the horse pulls back.
