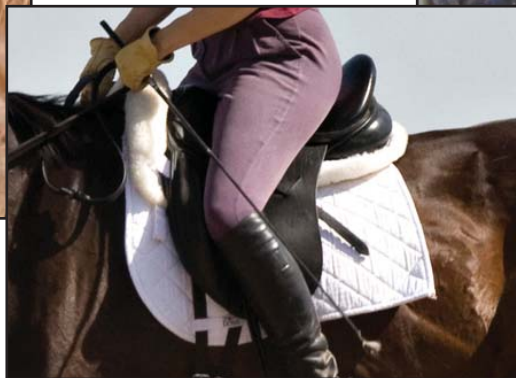

1. Custom Saddlery Trinity dressage saddle. Buffalo leather. Knee roll on top of flap (not concealed underneath), long billets - back billet is a "V" billet of nylon and heavy D ring with leather billet attached. Serial number 1752051904NJ
2. Circle "Y" dark oil show saddle, double skirt, silver on skirts, conchos, cantle plate. Silver ferruled, braided hobbles (in photo)
3. Blue Ribbon dark brown close contact saddle. Excellent condition. Did have cantle plate "S. Ellerman" (look for spot where it was attached, it has probably been removed).
4. Fabtron synthetic and leather combo western trail saddle. Saddle bags in picture were NOT stolen. Plastic stirrups.
5. White sheepskin Mattes half pad, "Dickerson" written along spine of pad.
6. Dover Wellington Saratoga hunt bridle, raised and padded with fancy stitching, raised and fancy stitched laced reins. Brass plate on crownpiece "BA Foxfire"
7. Silver western headstall, silver buckle has initials "SW" etched on underneath side
8. braided, weighted dark chocolate brown romal reins. No silver.
9. Lots of training tack - quick change headstalls, reins, martingales, bits, saddle pads.
10. Western saddle, mahogany brown color finish, saddle strings, no silver
11. Multiple halters, including black leather new cond. halter with brass plate "Cassidy's Song/Sarah Dickerson"
